## **How to Cite Sources**

When you **quote**, **summarize**, **or paraphrase** information from a source, you must cite your source to give credit to the person or people who wrote the piece. If you do not cite your sources, it is considered to be **plagiarism** (taking the work or idea of someone else and passing it off as one's own; the act of copying from someone)

Why is it important to have a reference (works cited) page where you list all of the websites
and books you used to find your information?
Where can you find information for your works cited page (where in the book or on a website will the information be)?
